Peace and Trade Uniting to Rule the World

is an allegory appearing on a series of $\ensuremath{\mathsf{FRENCH}}$ $\ensuremath{\mathsf{STAMPS}}$

we call them PAIX ET COMMERCE

as TYPE SAGE.

SAGE last name after their designer Jules Auguste Sage

The stamps were engraved by Louis-Eugène Mouchon.





PEACE in the care of a goddess carrying an olive branch and COMMERCE taking the appearance of the Greek god Hermes $\label{eq:commerce} \text{they hold hands above a globe.}$

Issued in 1876, SAGE replace

the stamps of the Second Empire Napoleon III and the CERES for the République.



A SAGE type I is finished, but due to the deformation during the quenching the die is broken and rebuilt a type II becomes variant of letters positions.
