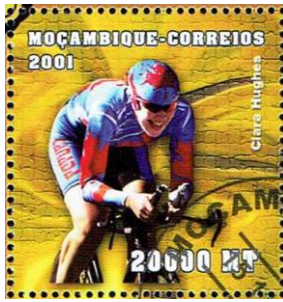


OLYMPIANS WHO EARNED MEDALS IN BOTH WINTER AND SUMMER GAMES

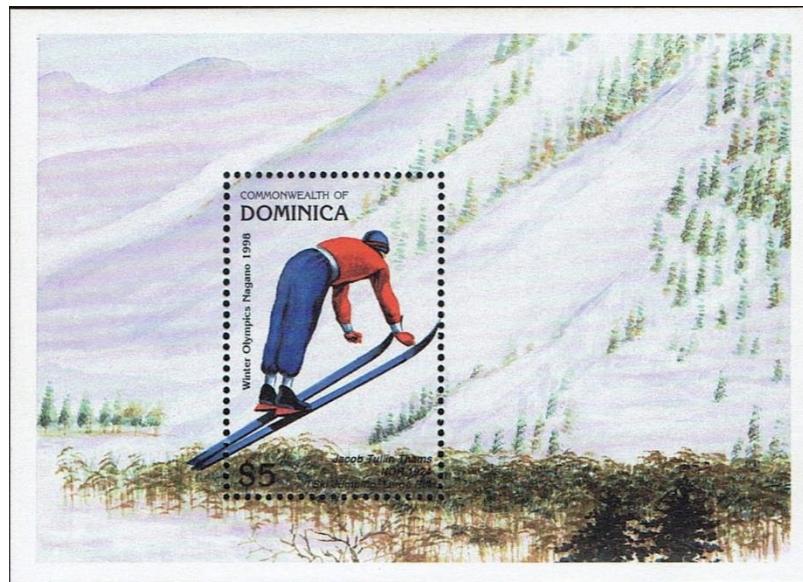


Clara Hughes (Canada) earned two medals in cycling (1996) and four in speed skating (2002-10).



Christa Luding-Rothenburger (East Germany) won four medals in speed skating (1984-92) and one in cycling (1988).

Eddie Eagan (USA) won two gold medals (boxing in 1920 and bobsleigh in 1932).



Jacob Tullin Thams (Norway) won gold in ski jumping (1924) and then silver in sailing (1936).

The only winter/summer Olympic medalist not featured on any stamps is Lauryn Williams (USA), who won two medals in athletics (2004, 2012) and then a silver medal in bobsleigh (2014).
