## SCOUTS AND GUIDES: KNOTS

THE ANIMATED AND ILLUSTRATED KNOTS IN THIS SECTION WILL TEACH SCOUTS HOW TO TIE 16 ESSENTIAL KNOTS USED IN SCOUTING. THE TYING OF KNOTS IS AN IMPORTANT PART OF THE SCOUTING PROGRAM FOR BOTH BOY SCOUTS AND GIRL SCOUTS.

THE PALOMAR KNOT IS A SIMPLE, BUT VERY STRONG AND EFFECTIVE, KNOT. IT IS RECOMMENDED FOR USE WITH BRAIDED LINES, AND IS SO SIMPLE THAT WITH A LITTLE PRACTICE IT CAN BE TIED IN THE DARK. IT IS REGARDED AS ONE OF THE STRONGEST AND MOST RELIABLE FISHING KNOTS.

KNOTS ARE A CRUCIAL PART OF SCOUTING AND OUTDOOR SURVIVAL. THE FOLLOWING KNOTS A SCOUT MUST LEARN TO REACH THE FIRST-CLASS RANK ARE THE: SQUARE KNOT, TWO HALF-HITCHES, TAUT-LINE HITCH, SHEET BEND, BOWLINE, CLOVE HITCH, TIMBER HITCH, FISHER MAN KNOT, PALOMAR KNOT.




