ROBERT STEPHENSON SMYTH BADEN-POWELL, KNOWN AS B-P WAS BORN AT NUMBER 6, STANHOPE STREET (NOW 11, STANHOPE TERRACE) PADDINGTON, LONDON ON 22nd FEBRUARY 1857. HE WAS ALWAYS EAGER TO LEARN NEW SKILLS. HE PLAYED THE PIANO AND THE VIOLIN. WHILE AT CHARTERHOUSE HE BEGAN TO EXPLOIT HIS INTEREST IN THE ARTS OF SCOUTING AND WOODCRAFT. THE NAME OF BADEN POWELL IS KNOWN AND RESPECTED THROUGHOUT THE WORLD AS THAT OF A MAN WHO IN HIS 83 YEARS LED TWO SEPARATE AND COMPLETE LIVES, ONE AS A SOLDIER FIGHTING FOR HIS COUNTRY, AND THE OTHER AS A WORKER PEACE THROUGH THE BROTHERHOOD OF THE SCOUT MOVEMENT.
