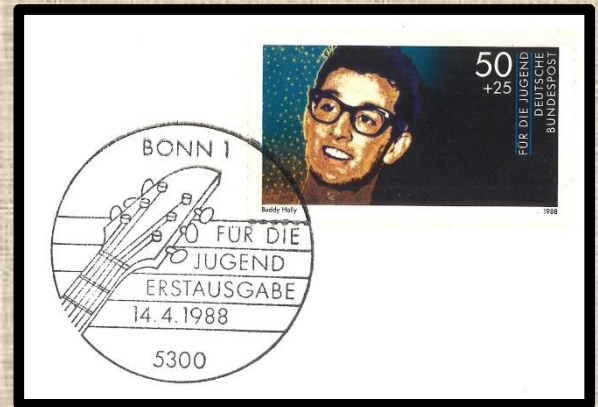


Tanzania, 1995

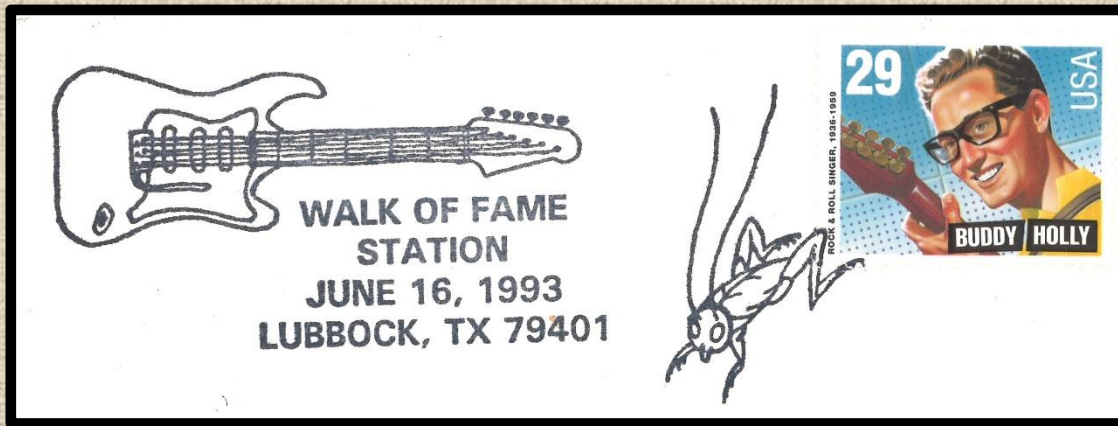
Buddy Holly was a US-American rock 'n' roll musician and songwriter.

His career lasted just a few years before he died in a plane crash in 1959 at the age of only 22.

Despite this, he has had a lasting influence on the music scene up to the present day.

With the support of his backing band "The Crickets", his greatest achievements were "Peggy Sue", "That'll be the day" and "Oh Boy!"

On 3 February 1959, he boarded a "Beechcraft Bonanza" plane which crashed a few minutes after taking off.

All four passengers died, including Buddy Holly and the musician Ritchie Valens.

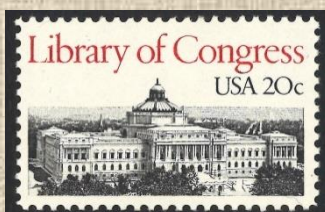
