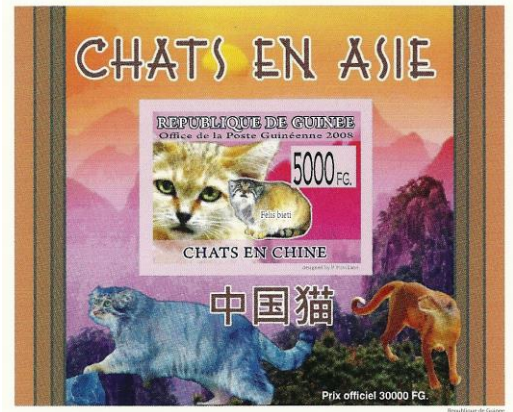


Endangered Small Wild Cats



Andean cat (*Leopardus jacobita*) is the most threatened and only IUCN Red List Endangered cat in the Americas. Less than 2,000 remain in the high Andes of Peru, Argentina, Bolivia, and Chile.

Borneo bay cat (*Catopuma badia*), lower right on stamp, is found only on the island of Borneo. Fewer than 2,500 remain.



Flat-headed cat (*Prionailurus planiceps*) occurs in Malaysia, Sumatra & Borneo. Palm oil plantations have destroyed most of the peat swamp forests where flatties occur.



Iberian lynx (*Lynx pardinus*) occurs in southern Spain and Portugal. When the total wild population dropped below 100 individuals, conservation efforts saved the Iberian lynx from certain extinction.
