Kurunji is one of the most tourist attracting flower in South India especially in Kerala's Munnar. The rare Neelakurunji flowers which grow up to 30 to 60 cms high, bloom only once in the Plant's life time. The phenomenon occurs once in 12 years following which the plant perishes. Strobilanthes Kunthiana known as Kurunji or Neelakurunji in Malayalam and Tamil is a shrub that is found in the Shola forests of the Western Ghats in Kerala, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu. India Post brought out a stamp and miniature sheet in the year 2006.
