

# X-Rayed Ontario Government Mail

In the 2000's, after several incidents of suspected anthrax sent to its offices, the Government of Ontario began x-raying mail that had no return addresses and suspicious packages. These two covers were x-rayed by the Government Mail Service. The Government Mail Service is not Canada Post; it is the Government of Ontario's unit that receives mail from Canada Post and distributes it to government offices. The initials "MGCS" stand for Ministry of Government and Consumer Services, the ministry that ran the Government Mail Service at the time.
