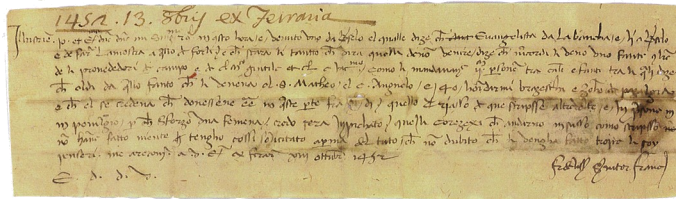
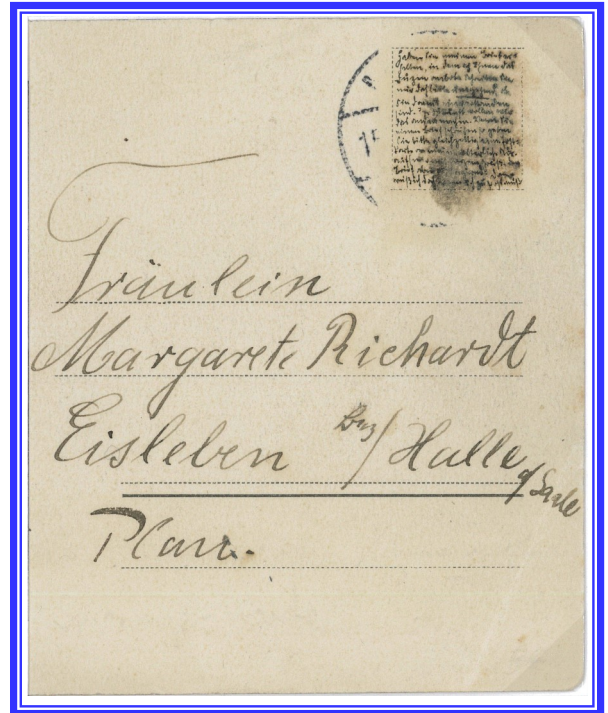


A secret is usually confidential information assigned to one or more persons. It should not be known or visible to a group of strangers for whom it is/could be of interest.

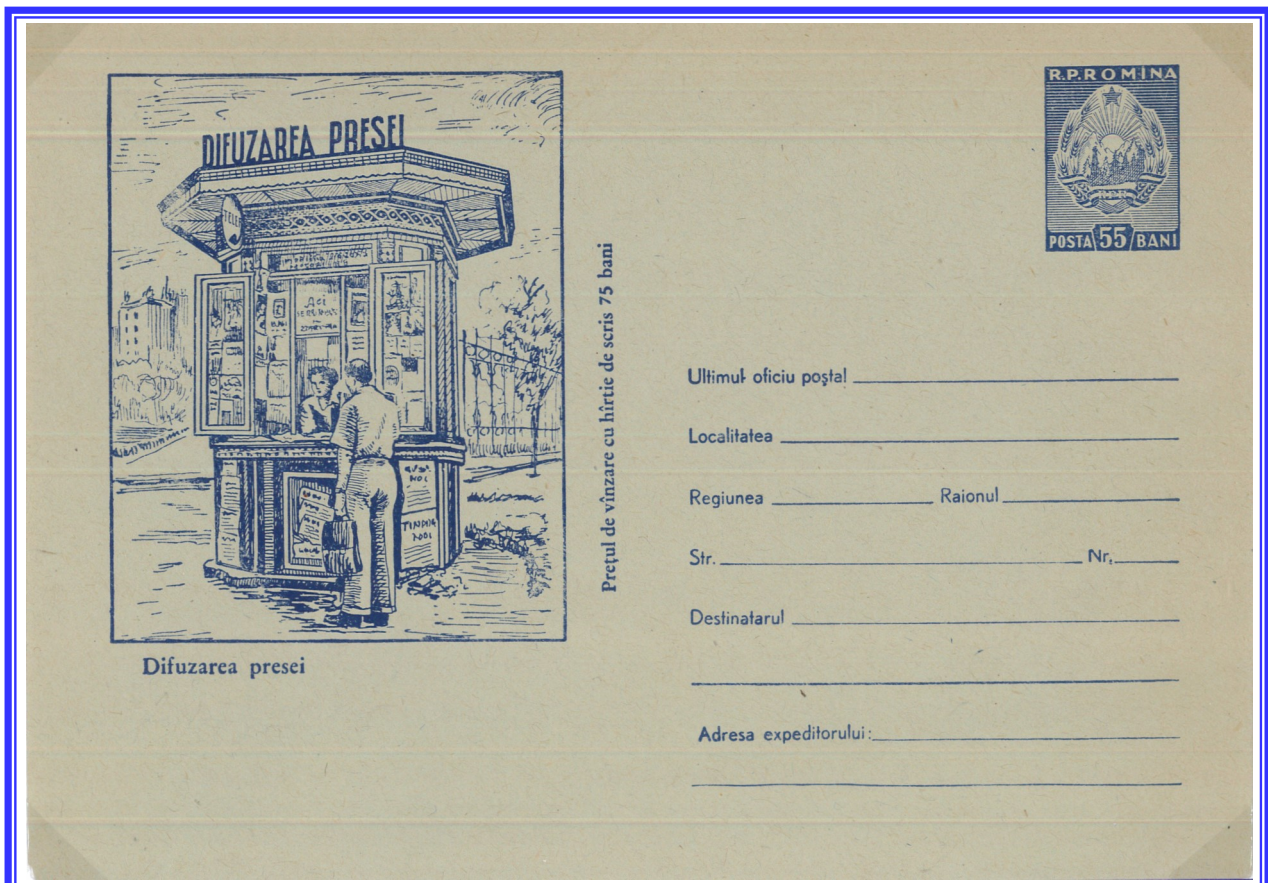
