## NATIONAL SYMBOL OF USA-STARS AND STRIPES FLAG

AMERICAN FLAG ,the most recognizable symbol of USA. Since its creation in the late 18 th century, the stars and stripes has flown proudly through war and peace , stateside and abroad and even on surface of moon.

The flag is customarily flown year-round at most public buildings, and it is not unusual to find private houses flying full-size (3 by 5 feet (0.91 by 1.52 m)) flags. Some private use is year-round, but becomes widespread on civic holidays like Memorial Day, Veterans Day, Presidents' Day, Flag Day, and on Independence Day.

The current design of the U.S. flag is its 27<sup>th</sup>, the design of the flag has been modified officially 26 times since 1777. The 48-star flag was in effect for 47 years until the 49-star version became official on July 4, 1959.



The 50-star flag was ordered by then president **Eisenhower** on August 21, 1959, and was adopted in July 1960. It is the longest-used version of the U.S. flag and has been in use for over 61 years.
