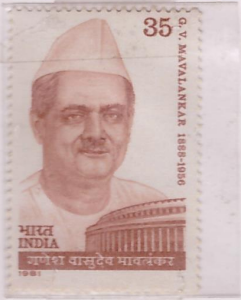
PICTORIAL CANCELLATION OF PARLIAMENT BUILDING ON FIRST DAY COVER, ISSUED ON: 23.09.2007
