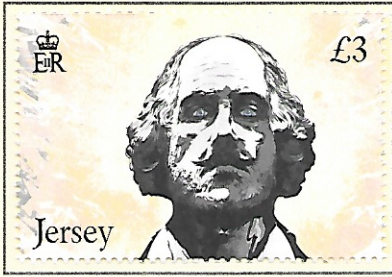


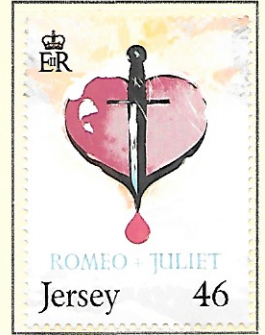
Tragedy of Romeo and Juliet

The wounded heart.



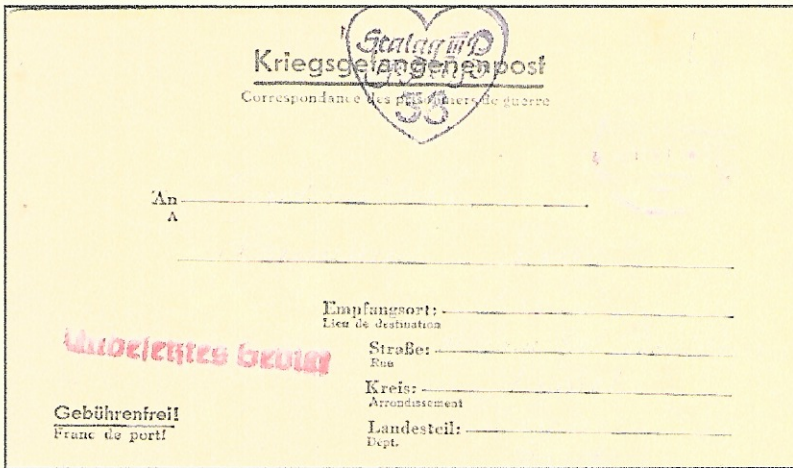
Love, a tormented heart.

A heart to fight and conquer.



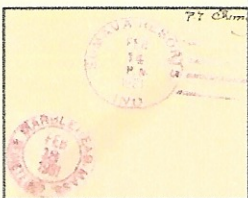
11/13/1941 - Correspondence prisoners of War, Stalag III D (censorship heart) to Nimes, France. (Reduced scan).



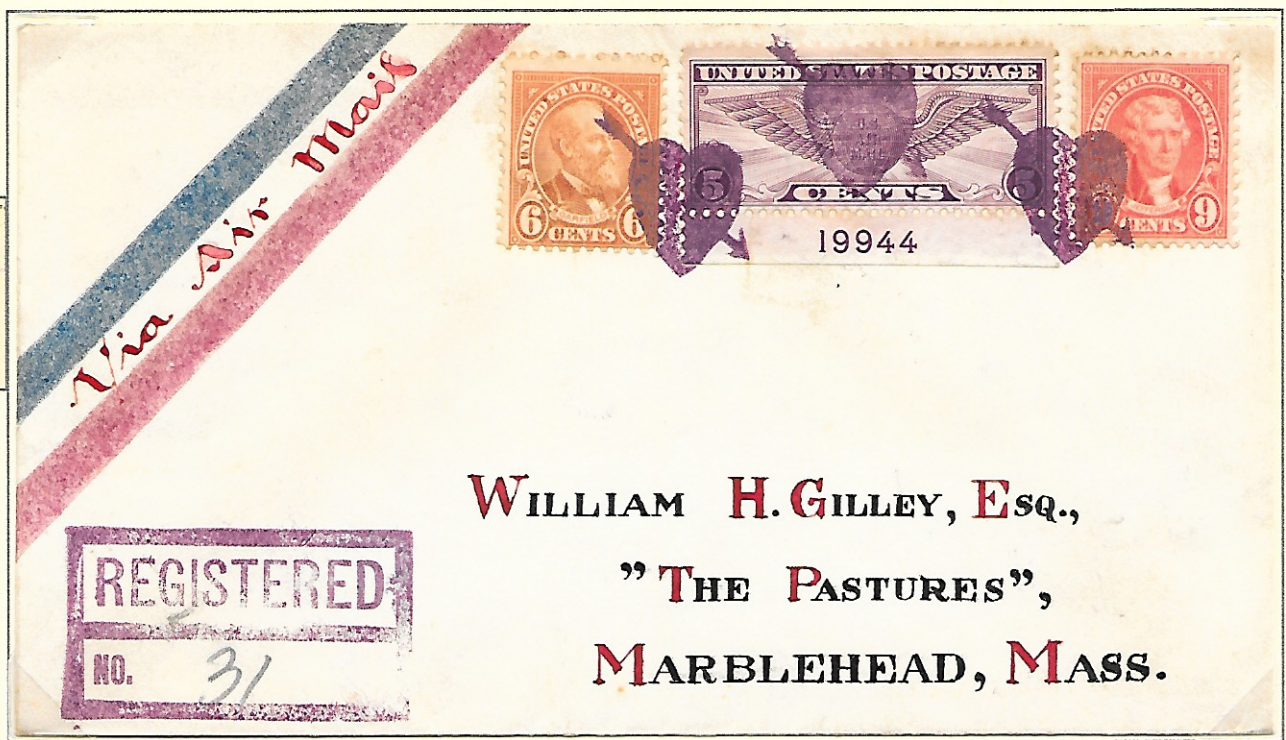
Sergei Prokofiev (1891-1953), composer.
