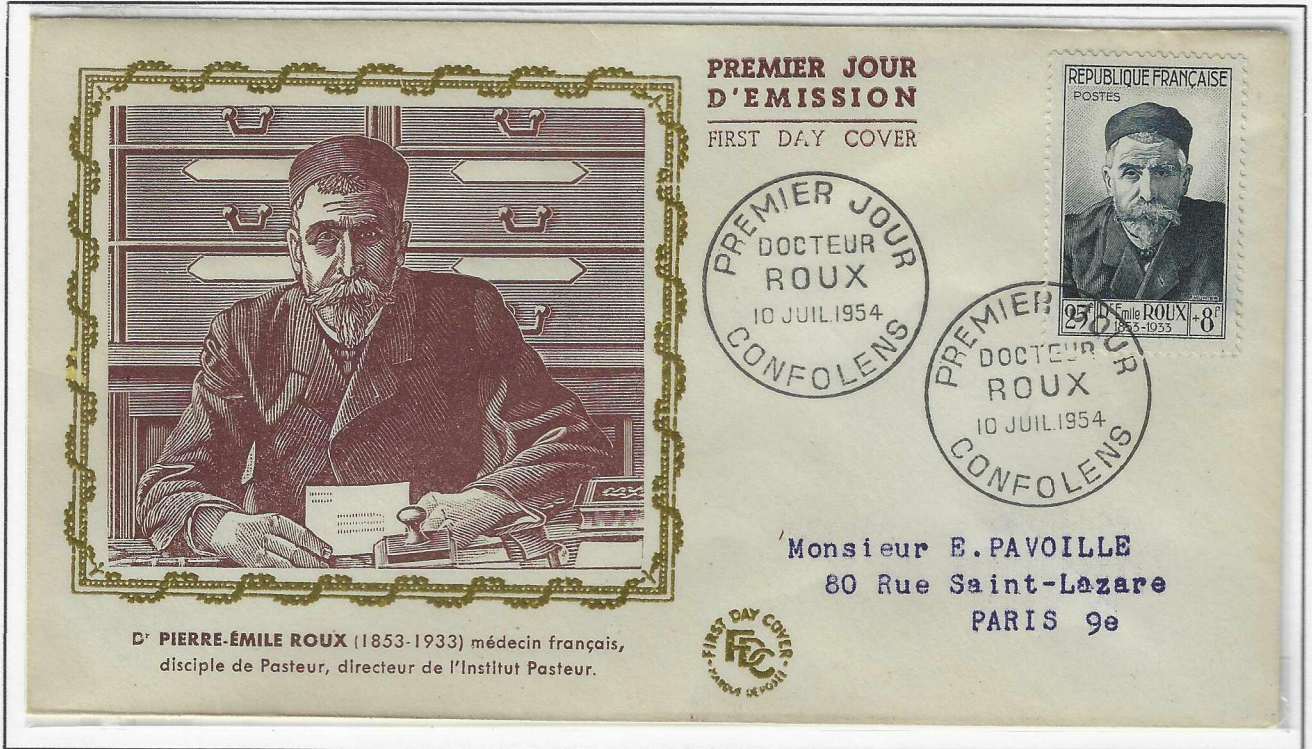
Hepatitis B vaccine

To control diseases such as Diphtheria, tetanus, tuberculosis, Poliomyelitis , yellow fever, Plague



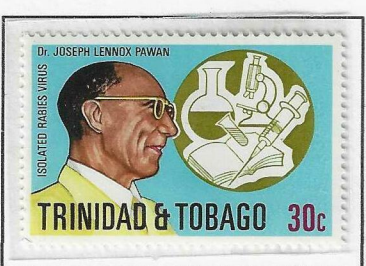
1961- Central African Republic – Opening of Pasteur Institute, Bangui

Joseph Lennox Donation Pawan

was a Trinidadian bacteriologist (Studied in PASTEUR INSTITUTE – PARIS – 1912) who was the first person to show that rabies could be spread by vampire bats to other animals and humans.
