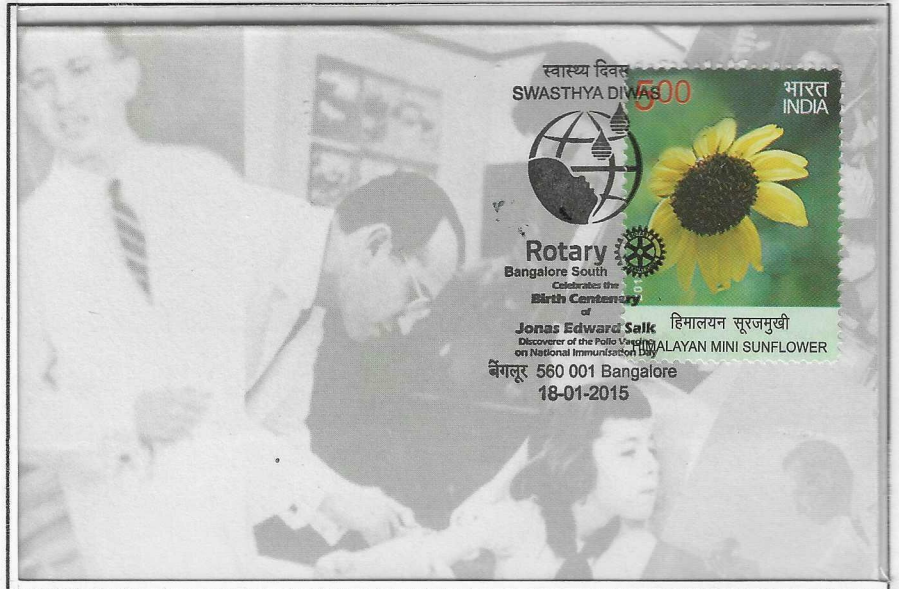


POLIO VACCINE (IPV)



Polio is a **disabling and life-threatening disease caused by the poliovirus**. The virus spreads from person to person and can infect a person's spinal cord, causing paralysis

Polio vaccines are vaccines used to prevent poliomyelitis. Two types are used: an inactivated poliovirus given by injection (IPV) and a weakened poliovirus (OPV) given by mouth. The World Health Organization recommends all children be fully vaccinated against polio
