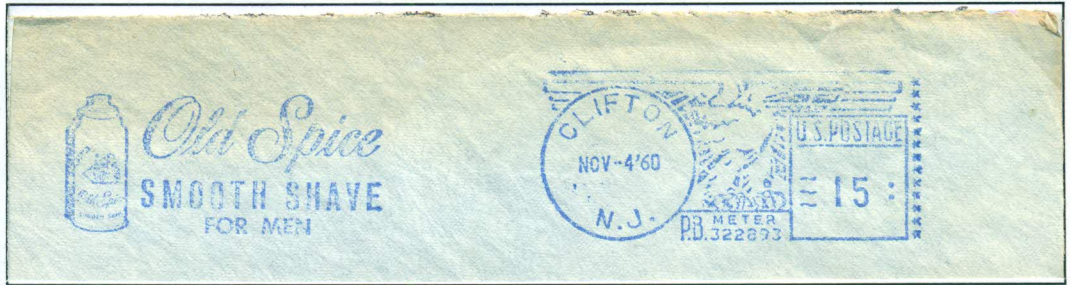


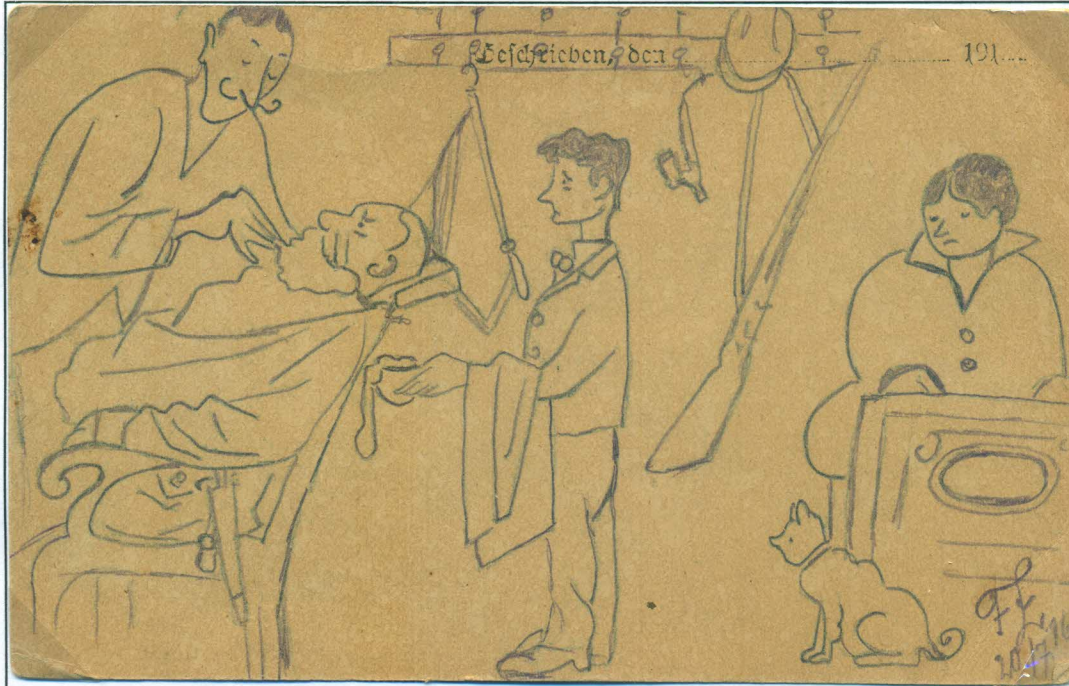

# A VISIT TO THE BARBER



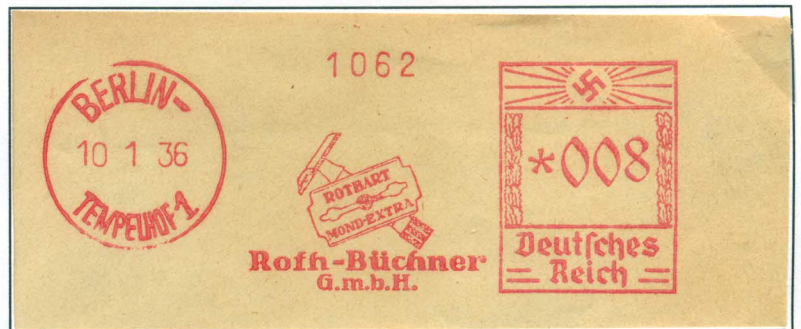
The barber loves to shave, cut and groome beards and moustaches.

*Meter Stamp Pitney Bowes Group 1A USA frameless with seated eagle type RF/RT serie Abbreviation state: N.J*



*Field postcard sent on 1916, July 20th with a sketch on the reverse: soaping the beard*

To soften the beard hairs, soaping is required. This is done with a brush and covers the beard and/or moustache in its entirety or partially.



The barber used to work with a razor, sharpened on a leather band. Today he prefers to work with a razor in a holder. Finishing with a shaver is also a possibility.

*Meter stamp Francotyp A, large date without dots, with counter number centralised at the top and swastika in vertical corner top.*



*Meter stamp Francotype Cc "A" with prefix F Frame: 28x28 mm – Dating with dots*



The goal is to achieve as end result a smooth shave or well-groomed beard and/or moustache.
