May 1, 1929, 8:00 PM, the "Last Post" is sounded for the first time at the Menin Gate in commemoration of the British and Commonwealth fallen. Except for the occupation period 1940/44, this daily tribute is maintained. Blown more than 33,000 times at the Menin Gate in Ypres.
