

PERUVIAN INFLUENTIAL WOMEN

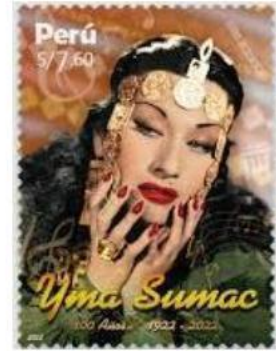

MUSIC: CHABUCA GRANDA
 María Isabel Granda y Larco, Apurímac, 1920-1983, emblematic figure of our Creole music. Its theme "The Flower cinnamon", which transcended in the time to become the anthem of the whole world. Peru.



MUSIC: YMA SUMAC
 Zoila Emperatriz Chávarri Castillo, soprano with A voice characterized by authenticity. She was born in Cajamarca from 1922 to 2008 and was one of the Peruvians who went the furthest in terms of singing and acting. She is the only Peruvian to Have a star on the Walk of Fame in Hollywood.



MUSIC: LUCHA REYES
 Lucila Sarcines Reyes, 1936-1973. Baptized as "The Golden Morena of Peru" and so on It was etched in the country's memory. She turned pain into feeling and sang 'Come back' and 'My Private Property'. Your Voice He became a legend.



RELIGION: SAINT ROSE OF LIMA
 Isabel Flores de Oliva was born in 1586 and died at the age of 31 full of youth, after a life of faithfulness to God. He belonged to the order of the Dominicans and practiced their love by praying and doing penance.



INDEPENDENCE HEROINE : MICAELA BASTIDAS
 She was the wife of Tupac Amaru II, with Who participates in the rebellion that breaks out in Tinta in 1780, after the execution of Corregidor Arriaga. Born in Abancay joined the feat as tenacious Counselor.
