JOINT ISSUES THROUGH STAMPS

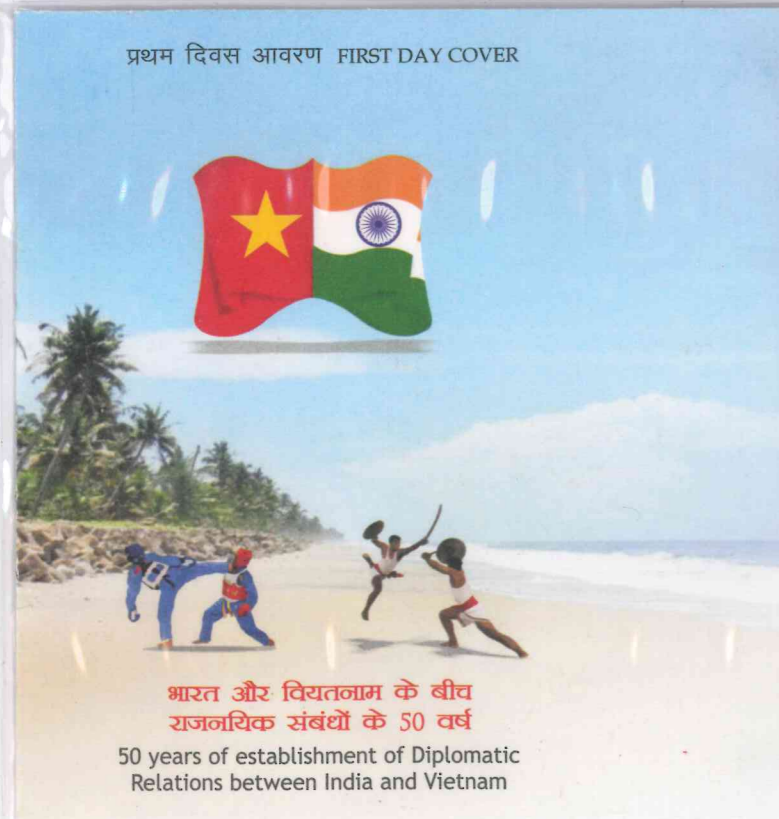
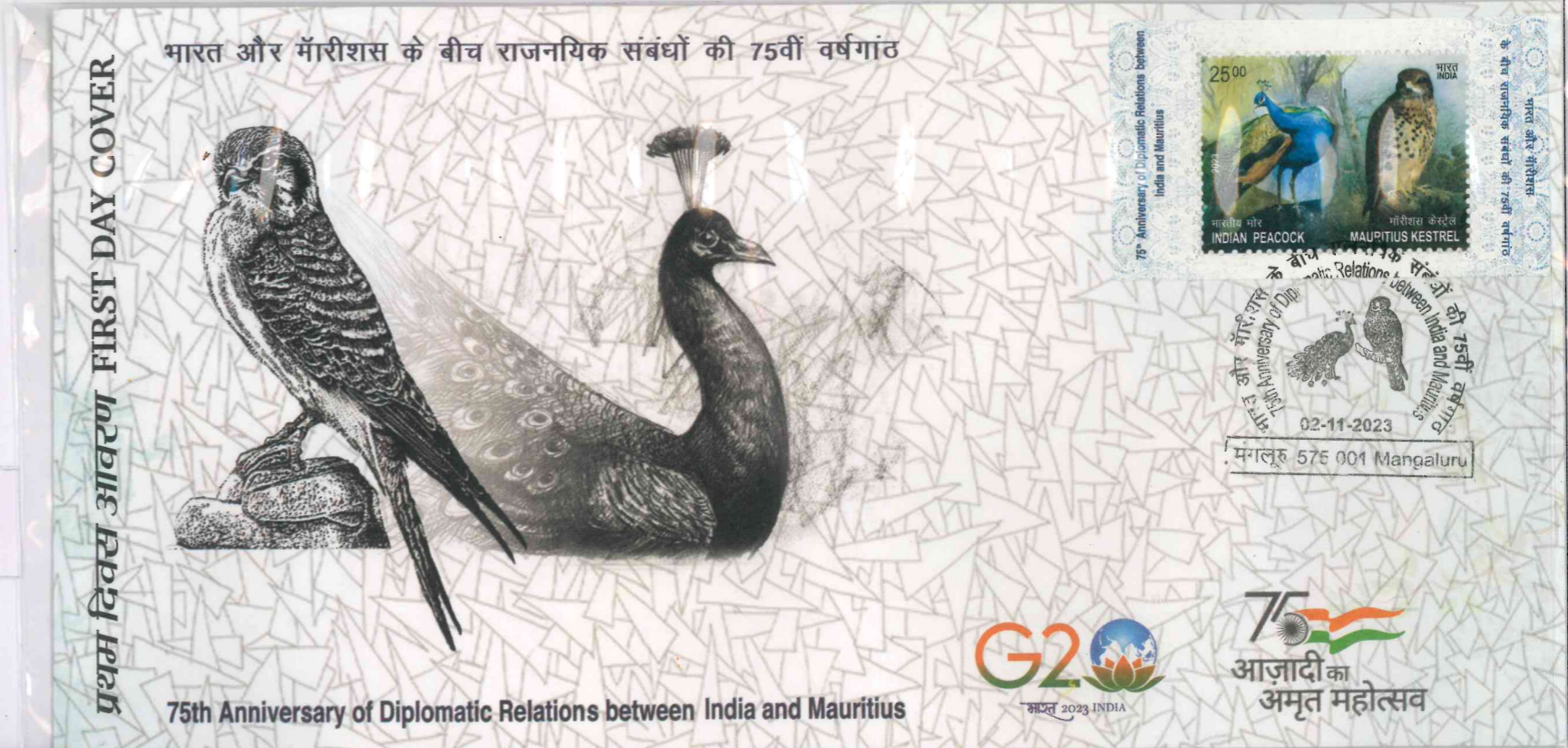
Bilateral Cooperation are the legal agreements between two nations on mutually accepted terms and conditions that facilitate the infrastructural development of the nations involved in the agreement, further increase avenues for economic development also. A joint issue is when postal administrations of two or more countries work together to issue stamps or postal stationery on the same date to commemorate the same event or honor the same person, place or idea. Usually the vignette is the same, framed with different lettering and denominations. This exhibit shows such bilateral or joint issues between India and other countries through stamps. It consists of miniature sheets and First Day Covers. It consists of 50 years of diplomatic relation between India and Vietnam, 75th Anniversary of diplomatic relation between India and Mauritius and Joint celebration of the year of 50th anniversary of UAE's formation and 75th anniversary of the year of the Independence of India(india stamp) jointly issued by Emirates Post and India Post.

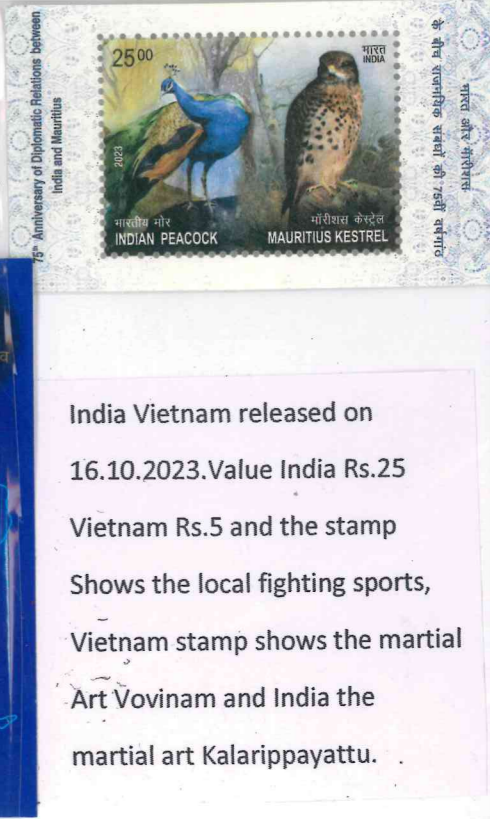
