Shri Ram Janmbhoomi Kshetra Prana Prathishta Celebrations

The Rama Mandir is situated in Ayodhya in the state of Uttar Pradesh which was ruled by King Rama, considered his Janmbhoomi and was brought back alive one again by the Praan Pratishsha of the statue of Lord Rama in the temple on 22nd January by our Honourable Prime Minister Shri. Narendra Modiji uner the guidance of Shree Ram Jhanmabhoomi Kshetra. The 'Pran Pratishta' ceremony involves a 48-minute-long ritual that infuses life into the idol of Lord Ram. It is conducted amid Vedic chanting and marks the moment when the idol becomes a living entity. The Rama Mandir is constructed in the traditional Nagara style, is a three storied mandir, measuring 380 feet in length (E - W) 250 feet in width and 161 feet in height. It is constructed with 392 pillars and has 44 doors. It has five mandaps or halls which are Nrity Mandap, Rang Mandap and Kirta mandap. The hief architect of the temple is Shri. Chandrakant Sompura who was assisted by his two sons. It is constructed as per vaastu and shipa shastras.

The ceremony will be done under the guidance of Pandit Laxmikant Dixit along with 121 Vedic Brahmins from across the country. This will happen under the Sanjeevani Yoga which is the most auspicious yoga and will be performed under the Abhijeet muhurut. Idol installation will start from 12.29 pm to 12.30 pm in 84 seconds. The function began on January 16th with a city tour, 17th January Pran Pratishta will begin after worshipping Lord Ganesha, 18th January the process of consecration will start with Mandap entry pujam, Vaastu puja and Varun puja, 19th January Yagya fire pit will be prepared at the temple and the fire will be lit by the priest by chanting of vedic mantras, 20th January the sanctum Sanctorium of Ram Mandir will be sanctified with 81 kalash which are filled with water from different sacred rivers, 21st January Ram Lala will take bath and the Yagya will be performed and 22nd January the consecration of Ram Lala will take place.


