

Longest Stamps of the World

Stamps or the so called small pieces of paper have been in use as the postage charge since the release of Penny Black in 1840. At first, these pieces of paper served its purpose, but soon it became the show case of the nation as these stamps served to travel through mail to long unknown places. Different varieties of stamps were released in different shapes, sizes, with additional elements like fragrance, and latest adding technology like QR code, crypto and what not. World's largest stamp is said to be "Mother of Emirates", released by UAE to commemorate Mother's Day which was 1.36 x 1.77 meters. Technically it is a special stamp as it could not be used as postage stamp. Here some of the extra-long stamps which could be used as postage are displayed.



Current Longest Stamp of the World is 2023 released **KYRGYZSTAN** stamp to commemorate "International Year of Sustainable Mountain Development" measuring 184 mm



2018 released **MALAYSIA** stamp featuring "Sungai Rajang river-RIVERS in Malaysia" measuring 160 mm



Until 2023, the longest stamp was 2017 released **THAILAND** stamp to celebrate "70th Anniversary Of Majesty's Accession To Throne" measuring 170 mm



2011 released **SRI LANKA** stamp to commemorate "Viceroy Special Train 25th Anniversary" measuring 123 mm



2020 released **SINGAPORE** stamp depicting "Skyline of Marina Bay Central District" measuring 163.2 mm



2019 released **SINGAPORE** stamp depicting "ASEAN Costumes" measuring 119.4 mm

Above are some of the extra wide stamps (more than 100 mm length) released around the world. These stamps usually allow more space to accommodate long images or series of images.
